The Vancouver Biennale is a non-profit organization that since 1998 transforms public spaces into an open air museum by installing works of art from internationally celebrated contemporary artists, freely accessible to citizens and visitors alike.

Unique among biennales worldwide, the Vancouver Biennale celebrates art in public spaces, where people work, live, play and commute. Accessibility, engagement, diversity, interaction and education are the cornerstones of the Biennale.

The 2014-2015 exhibition, titled OPEN BORDERS/CROSSROADS VANCOUVER, will celebrate multiculturalism and welcome the world.

OPEN BORDERS/CROSSROADS VANCOUVER will showcase the best and brightest in international contemporary art. You can look forward to experiencing art from a variety of disciplines including sculpture, music, new media, dance and film.

The Biennale's impressive international curatorial team will work closely with each of the partnering communities (at this point Vancouver, Richmond and North Vancouver) in creating 'live site' pavilions easily accessible and within walking distance of rapid transit.

International Artist Residency Programme Starts March 2014

The Vancouver Biennale invited 92 emerging artists of merit from Canada, the US, Asia, Northern Europe, North Africa, the Middle East, and Latin speaking countries to Vancouver, including Brazilian names such as [Marcelo Moscheta](#), [Mariana Manhães](#) and Paulo Climachauska.

In keeping with the curatorial theme Open Borders/Crossroads Vancouver, the artists represent multiple cultural backgrounds, political histories, and multiple artistic disciplines including sculpture, film, music and spoken word.

The exhibitions will go on until October 2015, with artists participating in 4-6 week residency intervals starting March 2014. Each group will have a coordinator including such luminaries such as Ken Lum, Sam Carter, Gordon Price and the winner of the 2013 Leonore Annenberg Prize Khaled Hourani.

Each resident artist will lead public talks and public workshops through an alliance of local artist studios, local galleries and local arts organizations to engage a large local audience in each event.

The programme is inspired by Martin Luther King's *"I Have A Dream"*.

[Marcelo Moscheta](#)'s work reflects the concept of the exhibition since it challenges boundaries of territory and physics through art.

The artist collects natural objects such as rocks and wood, either displaying them in installations or reproducing them through drawings and photographs, evidence of his enchantment for nature and remote locations.
